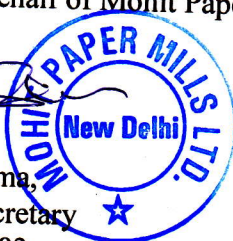

## NEWS IN BRIEF

## Three cops among six held for jail inmates' escape

**Gurgaon**  
Six people, including three policemen, have been arrested here for allegedly aiding the escape of two jail inmates.

The policemen were produced in a court on Tuesday, which remanded them in one-day police custody. The other three are being questioned, police said.

According to police, Abhijeet, a resident of UP, and Rakesh, a resident of Balabgarh in Haryana, were being taken to Delhi for treatment in a police vehicle when they fled from near Subhash Chowk.

Head Constable Nishu, Anil Kumar and Constable Naveen were taking them to the hospital.

"The preliminary probe revealed that there was negligence on the part of three cops," ACP Preet Pal Singh Sangwan said.

They were arrested and produced before a court, which sent them to one-day police custody, he said.

Police have also arrested Arvind, alias Anoop, a resident of Jharsa village; Ajay Jakhar, a resident of Naharpur Rupa; and Nitin Bhardwaj, a resident of Chakarpur. The ACP said they aided the escape of the jail inmates.

The probe revealed that Arvind and Ajay Jakhar came on a scooter to a hotel and handed over its keys to the jail inmates. "Efforts are underway to nab the absconders," said the ACP.

## Delhi minister warns of strict action for delay in issuance of caste certificates

**New Delhi**  
Delhi Social Welfare Minister Rajendra Pal Gautam on Tuesday said strict action will be taken against officials who do not complete the verification process for Scheduled Caste certificates within three days of receiving the applications.

He asked the officers to inform the Social Welfare Department of the status of SC certificate applications every two weeks.

"A number of applicants are coming forward with complaints of non-verification or non-issuance, and that their applications are being rejected. However, the department's SOP states that in such cases, field verification should be conducted to determine the applicant's caste and to ensure the issuance of SC certificate," a statement quoted Gautam as saying.

## Gurgaon court orders lie-detector test on suspended IPS officer

**Gurgaon**  
A court here ordered to carry out a lie-detector test on suspended IPS officer Dheeraj Setia, who has been booked in a case involving a multi-crore heist.

The multi-crore heist had taken place on August 4 last year, when Vikas Lagaripuriya's gang members broke into a flat from where the office of a private company was being run. They had decamped with crores of rupees in cash. Setia has been accused of the attempt to cover up the heist. The test will be conducted at a laboratory in Gujarat's Gandhinagar as the Special Task Force (STF) investigating the case had demanded suspecting that the accused may try to influence results if the test is conducted here.

## Improve greenery roads in west Delhi: CM to PWD

**New Delhi**  
Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday inspected a model stretch being redeveloped as per European standards in west Delhi's Pitampura area and directed PWD officials to improve the horticulture work.

Kejriwal was accompanied by his deputy Manish Sisodia and senior officials of the Public Works Department (PWD).

The PWD is developing 16 stretches of arterial roads on a pilot basis to create a model for streetscaping and redevelopment of its 500-km roads across the city.

Officials said roads in Delhi that are being developed as per European standards will represent patriotism with modernity as statues of freedom fighters will also be installed alongside streets.

During the inspection of the stretch from Britannia Chowk to Outer Ring Road in West Enclave in Pitampura, Kejriwal pointed out that the greenery on the



stretch was "not up to the mark" and needed improvement.

"Shrubs planted on the roadside need to be denser. More plantation should be there on the central verge," Kejriwal said during the inspection.

He said he was not very happy with the horticulture work being done on the stretch.

"We are beautifying 500-km PWD roads in Delhi as per European standards. For this, we are developing 16 stretches on a pilot basis across the city. These pilot

projects are likely to be completed by September or October. We will then review and finalise a model which will be best suited for the redevelopment of roads," Kejriwal told reporters.

PWD officials said that redesigning roads will eliminate bottlenecks and improve aesthetics.

A senior PWD official said the project entails strengthening roads, enhancing their aesthetics and greenery and introducing facilities like parking, kiosks, benches, decorative lights and water ATMs on the roadside.

Dedicated cycle paths and wide footpaths will make the stretches more pedestrian and bicycle-friendly.

Seven out of the 16 pilot stretches include Ring Road from Mayapuri to Moti Bagh Junction, Ring Road from AIIMS to Ashram, Vikas Marg-Laxmi Nagar Chungi to Karkari More, Narwana Road-Mother Dairy to Panch Mahal Nivas, Britannia Chowk to Outer Ring Road, West Enclave in Pitampura, Wazirpur Depot Crossing

(NSP) to Rithala Metro Station, Shivdaspur Marg and Patel Road (from Moti Nagar T-point to Pusa Road roundabout).

According to a statement issued by the government later in the day, greenery along the roads will be increased by planting different types of decorative plants.

Topiary group saplings will be planted by the roadside to make streets more visually appealing. In addition, saplings of bismarckia nobilis, roystonea regia, and phoenix dactylifera and palm family saplings will also be

planted.

"Being the capital of the country, Delhi deserves the most spectacularly built and well-developed roads. When we travel to other countries, to places like London, Tokyo, New York, Washington, or any European city, we see how beautifully and magnificently they are developed."

"Our roads are wide and well-paved but they are still not at par with the international standards, so to speak."

Hence, our aim is to improve the quality of roads in Delhi to these standards and make them more appealing and efficient to travel on," the statement quoted Kejriwal as saying.

The chief minister asked officials to plant taller and denser saplings along the roadside and on the central verge to make it more visually appealing.

"Along the road (in Pitampura), statues of freedom fighters such as Bhagat Singh and Rani Laxmi Bai have been installed to instil a strong feeling of nationalism in people," the statement said.

## DTC Cluster bus hits vehicles in Shastri Nagar; 9 injured

Nine persons have received severe injuries on Tuesday evening after a speeding cluster bus hit three auto and two motorcycles under North-East Delhi's Shastri Nagar flyover, said the police.

No casualty has been reported so far, they said.

The incident took place at about 4.45 PM, a Cluster Bus of route No. 214 while turning on pusta roads coming from IBSIT side hit the divider and some vehicles, said DCP North East.

Total nine persons have been reported injured and have been shifted to Jag Praveesh Chand Hospital. A newly married couple

has received critical injuries and has been referred to GTB hospital, they added.

A police team rushed on the spot and investigated the accident scene.

AAP MLA from Silampur, Abdul Rahman, also reached on the spot. He said, "The incident happened due to sudden break fail of bus."

"The bus was on high speed. It was coming from Kashmir gate side. When bus reached near Shastri Nagar flyover, it hit the divider, broke down it and hit two auto and two motorcycles," said an auto driver.

Police has registered a case against accused driver and investigation is underway.

## 3 students attacked by 'hooligans' inside Delhi's Ramjas College: SFI



**New Delhi**

Students Federation of India on Tuesday alleged that three students of Ramjas College here were brutally attacked by "hooligans" inside the campus and demanded strict action against the culprits.

Ramjas College Principal Manoj Khanna, however, said he had not received any complaint regarding the incident.

The students, who are SFI activists, were "verbally and physically" abused by some people following an argument, the students body said. They have been identified as Akhil, Sachin and Aman - all third-year students. They have suffered injuries in the incident, the SFI said. "SFI Delhi condemns the lack of student safety in campus spaces, and also the hooliganism demonstrated in Ramjas college today."

## Arrest of Jain is politically motivated; all allegations are completely bogus: Kejriwal

A day after Delhi health minister Satyendar Jain arrested by Enforcement Directorate, AAP National Convenor and Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal lashed out at the Central Govt for framing his cabinet minister Satyendar Jain in a bogus case.

He stated, "All allegations against Health Minister Satyendar Jain are completely bogus; his arrest is politically motivated. Had there been even one percent of truth in the case filed against Satyendar Jain, I'd have taken the strictest possible action against him. AAP is a party of honest deshbhaktis; we consider corruption to be treason; we can sacrifice our lives but won't steal even a paisa of taxpayer money. The whole country saw how we sacked our own minister in Punjab and sent him to jail. No one knew about the minister's corruption; had we wanted we could've brushed the matter under the carpets."

"In 2015, I had sacked the Food Minister from my cabinet in a similar manner and handed him over to the CBI. Not just India, but never has there been a party as honest as the AAP in the whole world. Centre filed bogus cases against several AAP MLAs, all of them were acquitted by the court; Shri Satyendar Jain too will walk out innocent. Every AAP worker knows they must always be ready to go to jail or even sacrifice their life if they have to keep up this movement Satyendar Jain has given the whole world a unique model of free healthcare; crores of those beneficiaries are praying for him," CM Arvind Kejriwal further stated.

Kejriwal said, "Delhi Health Minister Satyendar Jain was arrested by the Central Government's Enforcement Directorate yesterday. I studied his case files myself. The bogus case filed against Satyendar Jain is completely motivated and unsubstantiated. The Aam Aadmi Party and its governments are committed to the virtues of honesty, rectitude and deshbhakti. Neither do we engage in corruption worth even a single penny nor do we tolerate any kind of graft. We consider corruption the highest



form of treason. We will lay down our lives if need be but not engage in corruption. We can never betray our Bharat Mata."

He added, "The whole world is witness to how the Aam Aadmi Party's Punjab Government exemplified zero-tolerance to corruption when it immediately sacked and sent its own minister to jail when they found him engaging in corruption. Not a single agency, politician or media person was aware of what was going on. We could have brushed off the matter under the carpets had we wanted to, but we chose to walk on the path of honesty and acted against him. We can not trade our souls and betray the nation."

He continued, "In 2016, I had taken similar action against the Food Minister of my cabinet. I immediately sacked and handed him over to the CBI. Not just in India, but there's not a single party in the whole world who has committed themselves to honesty like AAP has. The day we sent our minister to jail in Punjab, people from all over India called us to congratulate. They said that they had never thought that there'd be a day where they'd see a party as honest as AAP."

The Delhi CM said, "I have studied every aspect of Satyendar Jain's case in depth. I am an educated man. I have good knowledge of such cases and the laws. I can confidently say that the whole case is a sham and a bogus being played for political interests. He is suffering due to dirty politics. Had there been even one percent truth in this case, I would have been the first one to act against him. They've filed several such cases against the majority of our MLAs. All of them were acquitted from the court of law."

He added, "Satyendar Jain is a staunch patriot. He is extremely honest and courageous. Such jails can never break his honesty and courage but only add on to it. I can understand what his wife and children must be going through. I want to tell them that he is a man of great valour. He gave the world a unique model of Mohalla Clinics. He gave the nation an example of what a health system should be like. The crores of people being treated for free under that health system are praying and showering blessings on him. The Lord is watching, I am certain that he is on our side. We have

full faith in the judiciary. He will walk scot-free from the court of law."
